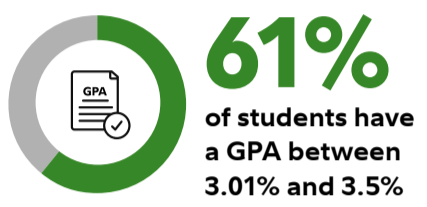
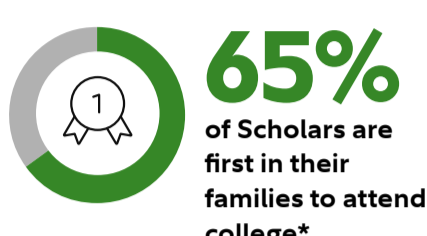
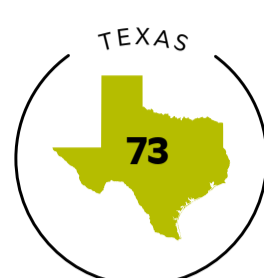




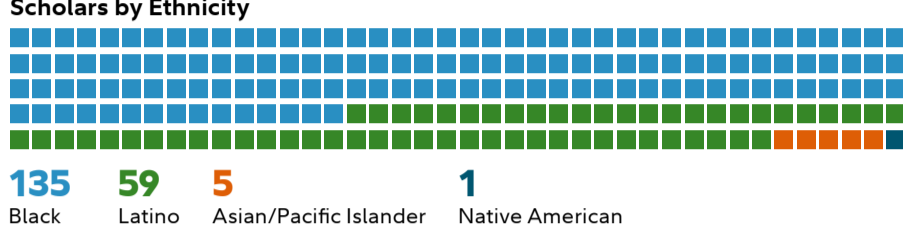
The 2023 Class of Fidelity Scholars

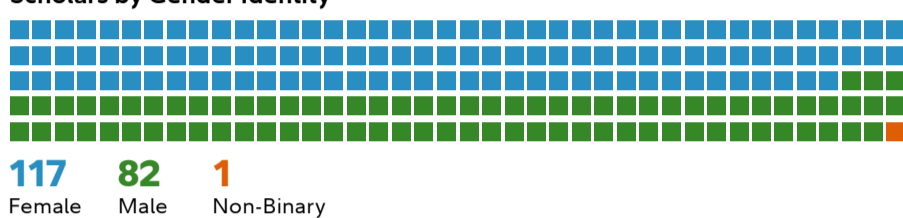

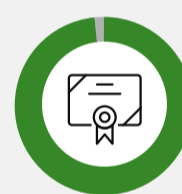
