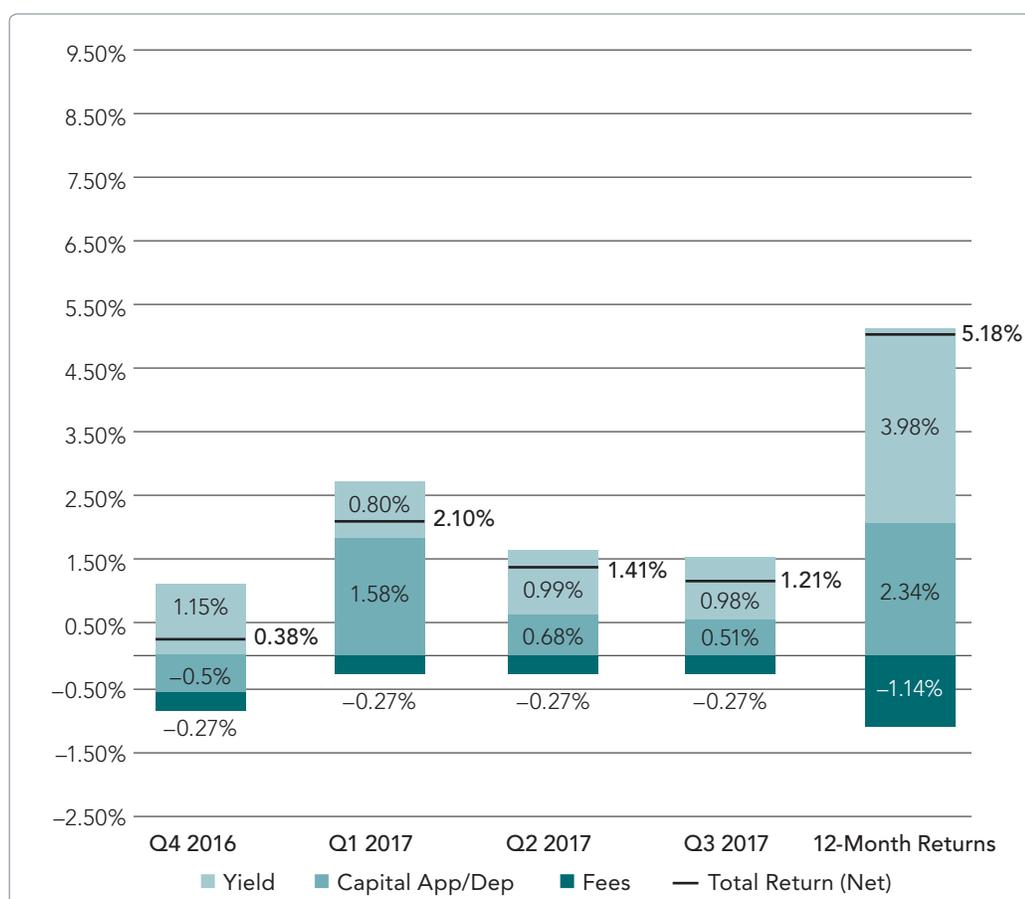
#### Investment Approach

- The BlackRock Diversified Income Portfolio is managed to a level of volatility that is generally consistent with a balanced portfolio,<sup>4</sup> thereby potentially making ups and downs less extreme.

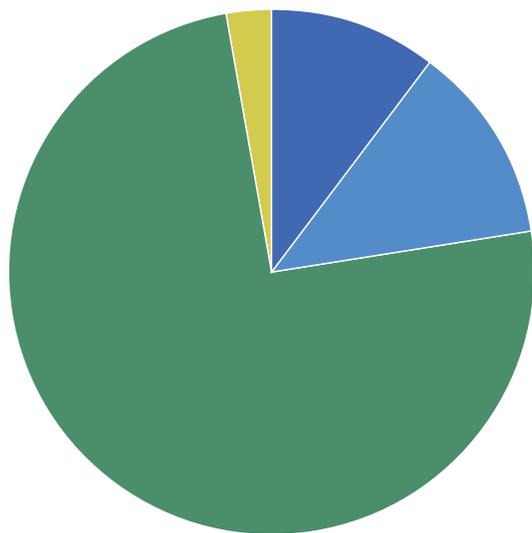

Standard deviation is a measure of the dispersion of a set of values from its mean. It is an annualized figure that measures how much a return varies over an extended period of time. The more variable the returns, the larger the standard deviation. A higher standard deviation indicates a wider dispersion of past returns and thus greater historical volatility. Standard deviation indicates the volatility of an investment's or an index's return over time, not the actual performance of the investment or market index.

Capital App/Dep does not include the components that make up Yield, but does include any change in value attributable to the reinvestment of the income generated by the model portfolio’s investments within a month. “Yield” is a measure of the income generated by the model portfolio’s investments and is expressed as a percentage of the model portfolio’s value. Yield for the model portfolio is calculated monthly as a percentage of the portfolio’s assets invested in the period. The income generated for each month is aggregated to arrive at a quarterly cumulative value, assuming the reinvestment of any income generated by the model portfolio’s investments at the end of every month during the quarter. The 12-Month Return is the cumulative income over the period (assuming the reinvestment of any income generated). This income is equal to the total of interest, dividends, and return of capital generated by the model portfolio’s investments during the applicable period. A return of capital is paid when an underlying investment makes a distribution that comes from a source other than interest, dividends, or realized capital gains. It is considered a return of a portion of the investor’s original investment. A return of capital is generally nontaxable and reduces the original cost basis with respect to the investment. “Fees” are all fees attributable to an investment in the model portfolio during the prior quarter, including the maximum annual advisory fee of 1.10%. Fees are assessed in arrears based on the average market value of the model portfolio during the prior quarter. Fees are shown as the difference between the cumulative three-month net and gross performance, which state fees as a percentage of the assets within the quarter. Fees for the BlackRock® Diversified Income Portfolio are fully described in the BlackRock® Diversified Income Portfolio Program Fundamentals.
