

# Tax Year 2020: Important Information for Massachusetts Residents

This information may assist you in preparing your Massachusetts state income tax return.

If, during 2020, you were subject to tax in Massachusetts and held shares of the fund(s) listed on the table below, you may have received federally taxable distributions that are partially or completely exempt from Massachusetts state income tax. In general, these amounts represent exempt gains or ordinary income realized by the funds on the sale of certain securities.

The amount of each capital gain and/or ordinary income distribution you received is reported:

- For **Fidelity brokerage accounts**, in the Supplemental Information portion of your 2020 1099 Tax Statement, find the Details of 1099-DIV Transactions, Total Ordinary Dividends and Distributions Detail section.
- For **Fidelity mutual fund accounts**, find the Transaction Details Section of your 2020 year-end statement or your applicable monthly/quarterly account statement.
